

2021 MALBEC

This Malbec displays a rich ruby hue and an inviting aromatic profile of juicy plums, fresh raspberries, and fragrant violets. Green and black pepper notes add vibrancy, while oak aging contributes layers of tobacco, vanilla, and dark chocolate. Full-bodied with round tannins, it achieves a seamless balance and a refined, lingering finish.

| WINEMAKING | Passed through two hand-sorting tables, first as whole clusters and then as single berries after destemming. Cold soak and fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Manual punch downs enhanced the wine's extraction. |
| AGING | 17 months in 100% new French oak barrels |
| PRODUCTION | 300 bottles Bottled October 18, 2022 |
